“Called to Protect Children Program” - Every school year we are required by the Diocese of Austin to implement "Called to Protect for Children Program for all kindergarten - 5th grade students. This program consists of three brief sessions per grade, that provides the students with basic understanding about boundaries, skills to know what to do if someone violates those boundaries, and facilitate conversations about keeping safe. We will conduct these sessions this week, April 19th through April 23rd.
