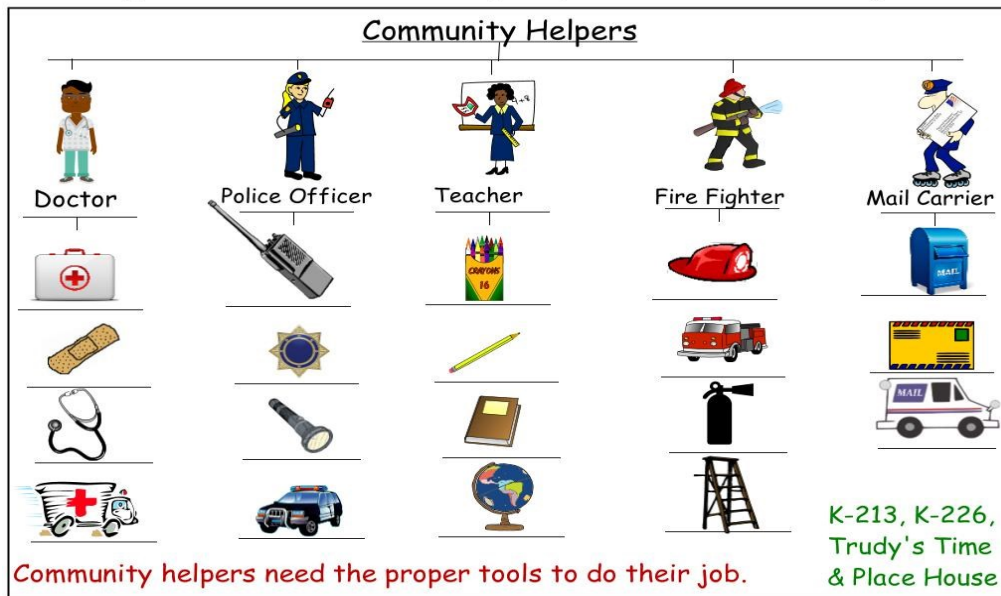
TREE MAP: CLASSIFYING

Key words: classify, sort, group, categorize, give sufficient and related details, types of, kinds of, list and elaborate, taxonomy.

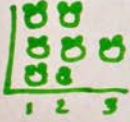
