FISH Program - The start of another school year brings us many opportunities to volunteer for the school. You can apply those hours towards your Family Involvement and Service Hours (FISH).

As a reminder, the Volunteer FISH Program provides opportunities for parents to work together to build a strong community spirit at St. Joseph Catholic School. All elementary families are expected to complete 10 hours of service, while the junior high and high school families are expected to complete 20 hours of service. If you have multiple children, you are required to complete the older child's service requirement. It is important to us to have all our families involved with service along with the opportunity to help us to build our community into one of constant service for others. If your family chooses not to provide fish hours, you will be charged \$12.50 per hour. All hours

are due on or before the end of the school year. Students of parents/families not fulfilling their FISH requirements (hours or payment) by that time will not receive their school transcript for the 2018-2019 year.

To submit your hours, email fish@stjosephbcs.org, and in the body of the email please include a concise description along with the number of hours volunteered.

Remember, in order for hours to be applied towards your balance, the hours must be used in service of St. Joseph Catholic School.

REMINDERS:

Lunch Program – Students may order a salad, baked potato, and PB&J offered by our kitchen, or a hot lunch from one of our outside designated vendors. Lunch and break must be ordered on Renweb by **Sunday(midnight)** for the upcoming week. The menu on Renweb, will detail what items can be ordered each day. Please understand that we CANNOT provide a lunch for a student that was not ordered by **Sunday(midnight)** before the upcoming week.

Payments for lunch – You can pay for lunches by check or cash with the front office. If you wish to pay by credit card, go to our school website at www.stjosephschoolbcs.org, click on the PARENTS tab, and then click on PAYMENTS. Please keep in mind there is a fixed convenience fee for each credit card transaction. Each family has one account for all family members, so one payment takes care of multiple students. Follow the directions provided carefully.

PARENT/STUDENT HANDBOOK - Please read over all of the information in the handbook with your child. The handbook is located online at www.stjosephschoolbcs.org, under the PARENTS tab. The last page of the handbook is a signature page that requires both parent and student signatures. The signature page **WAS DUE** to your child's third period teacher last Friday, August 18. If you have more than one child, please turn in one signature page per child.

Additional Forms to Sign and Return – Please review and sign the Technology Agreement and Medication Permit form. **Please understand that we CANNOT administer any medication unless the Medication Permit form is signed by the doctor.**

The school is open as early as 7:15am. Junior high students may be dropped off/picked up at the circle drive in the back of the school. High school students may be dropped off/picked up at the front of the school.

When dropped off in the morning,

- Junior high girls report to the Junior high boys report to the junior high hallway and wait for the first bell at 7:50am
- High school boys and girls will wait in the high school hallways until the first bell at 7:50am

After school procedures for junior high students – junior high students are to report to either athletic practice or extra-curricular activity. Students who don't participate in athletics or extra-curricular activities, may wait for their ride in the gated court yard.

**On the day of a sporting event taking place after school in the gym, all students are allowed to report to the gym to watch the sporting event until they are picked up
