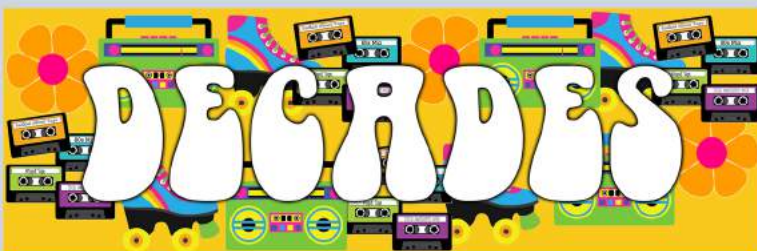

### HOME COMING DRESSES

The dresses should NOT be low cut in the front. Bare midriff is NOT allowed. Strapless is okay, but your lower back should NOT be exposed. The length, including slits, should be past the fingertips or no more than 3 inches above the knee. Mrs. Rayburn must be able to see the front and back of the dress for approval. All homecoming dresses must be approved by Mrs. Rayburn no later than Sept. 21. ### OUT-OF-SCHOOL DATES

If you are bringing an out-of-school date, you must have the permission form completed and turned in to Mrs. Kleiber by Sept. 21. You must purchase a ticket for your date. Dates more than one year out of school, or over the age of 18, are not permitted. Out-of-school date permission forms will be located in the front office and must be turned into Mrs. Kleiber. Out-of-school female dates must have their dresses approved by Mrs. Rayburn.
